Four Corners Community Bank rebuilds new, vibrant branch on 20th Street in Farmington, NM

FARMINGTON, NM (January 7, 2020) – Four Corners Community Bank (FCCB) recently completed demolition of the 47-year-old 20th Street branch in Farmington, NM (that FCCB acquired in 1999). The rebuild will start immediately, with project completion expected within the year—which is also the bank's 20th anniversary year (officially March 1, 2020).

“We are thrilled to be in a position to invest in this community and provide our customers with a new, modern, and technologically-advanced banking experience,” said President and CEO, Sheila Mathews. “The replacement of the former building will increase the property value of all those around it, as well as brighten the East end of 20th Street.”

A bright, inviting, and open floor plan (see internal rendering) will feature cash recyclers; universal bankers provide a wider range of banking services compared to traditional tellers (a concept known as *dialog banking*). This model has been successfully implemented in three other FCCB locations (500 West Main Street in Farmington, 77 West Main Street in Cortez, and 2685 Main Avenue in Durango).

With \$370 million in assets, seven locations, and over 90 employees, FCCB continues to grow into its 20th year. “Our growth is largely attributed to our commitment to working with local, small businesses throughout the region,” said Board Chairman, Frank Macaluso. “Our local board, shareholders, and staff all work and live in the communities we serve, and our deposits stay here too, and fund local loans. It’s all cyclical.”

During the rebuild, directional signage leads customers to an on-site mobile unit located directly south of the former building. Two operational drive-thru lanes are available. A new ATM will be installed upon completion. The mobile unit will operate on regular *weekday* hours, and is closed on Saturdays; the open New Mexico Saturday location has been moved to 5900 East Main Street in Farmington until project completion.
