

FCCB Coronavirus Update – July 17, 2020

Over the past few month New Mexico Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham and Colorado Governor Jared Polis have both issued public health orders relating to the COVID-19 coronavirus. Four Corners Community Bank has stayed up to date with these orders and we have taken appropriate steps to protect the health and safety of our customers and staff, while continuing to offer our banking services.

As a bank, Four Corners Community Bank is deemed an *essential business* and will continue to remain open to serve our customers.
