2000-2005: FCCB opens two additional locations in Farmington (including one new site-built location)

2006: FCCB expanded into Aztec, NM with another new, site-built location

2007: To connect the Four Corners region, FCCB crossed the border into Colorado opening its fifth location in downtown Cortez, now serving Montezuma County

2013: FCCB acquired Citizens State Bank of Cortez, its sixth location

2016: FCCB opened its seventh location in Durango, CO, widening its reach into La Plata County

2018: FCCB welcomed Dr. John McNeill and Paul Thompson to its board of directors

2019: FCCB began rebuilding its original home on 20th Street in Farmington

2020: FCCB celebrates its 20th birthday on March 1
